Shooting Times

The sports field is accessed via Cotteswold Road and is well maintained by the school and enables distances of up to 90 metres (100 yards) to be shot, with a clear overshoot area.

The club shoots outdoors all year.

Some of our members are fair weather archers who shoot on the days when the weather is more favourable. However, the more competitive archers will brave inclement weather to gain valuable practice and experience in all conditions.

Guests are always welcome, a shooting fee payable.

Your Archery GB card will be requested on arrival or at any time during the session.

To allow plenty of time for the rounds being shot, sighters will begin within 30 mins of the start time and the full scoring round will begin 15 mins later. The session will be timed to the archers shooting the scoring round.

NOTE:

The first Wednesday of every month is for bow tuning and those tuning will get priority on the shooting line.

All shooting days are subject to the facilities at the school being available. School events, Bank Holidays and other factors can result in sessions being cancelled at fairly short notice.

All club sessions are designated Club Target Days unless notified.
